1) District update

Superintendent Sullivan shared that we had twenty-five local veterans present at the first PHS Veterans Day event honoring their service. He also reported that last week we had 19 positive Covid -19 cases and 15 others quarantined. With Day Kimball Hospital's support we had just under 600 students and staff last Friday who got vaccinated or were able to get a booster shot.

2) Truck Disposal

Superintendent Sullivan reported the 2007 GMC Sierra needs repairs. Because of the extensive work needed, he is recommending we dispose of the vehicle. The Special Services District is looking to cycle out a truck in the spring that might be of interest to us.
