1. Recommend to the Board to warn for adoption the following PHS courses:
 - AP Psychology
 - Human Rights (CP & Honors)
 - SLIFE Math (ELL as Academic Lab)
2. Discussion followed for the possible course changes at Putnam High School:
 - AP Prep class to help students get acclimated or inclined to take an AP course and to be more successful in their endeavors.
 - Sequence of AP US History is still undecided as to whether this will be moved to grade 10.
 - African-American, Puerto Rican and Latin Studies - Mandatory for 2022/23 school year. SERC will develop the curriculum and Putnam will adopt it.
3. The following pathways that would lead to certifications for students were discussed. Concerns centered on the staffing necessary to fulfill the requirement, particularly CNA:
 - CNA certification
 - Fire Safety certification
 - Pharmacy Tech certification
